**ARCHDEACON OF CYPRUS ANNOUNCES HIS RETIREMENT** It was announced on Sunday 7 April that the Venerable Christopher and the Reverend Anne Futcher will be retiring at the end of September 2024. Christopher and Anne arrived in Larnaca in 2019 as Parish Priest and Associate Priest. Christopher is Archdeacon and Diocesan Director of Ministry, as well as Diocesan Safeguarding Adviser. Anne is Diocesan Social Concern Officer. They came to this Diocese from the Diocese of Exeter and will be returning to live in south-west England. They will both be sorely missed. Do keep Christopher and Anne in your prayers at this time.
