God of compassion, whose Son Jesus Christ, the child of Mary, shared the life of a home in Nazareth, and on the cross drew the whole human family to himself: strengthen us in our daily living that in joy and in sorrow we may know the power of your presence to bind together and to heal; through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. **AMEN.**

REVD PAUL WRITES I was involved in an amazing Zoom call with Archbishop Hosam last week on the theme of 'Christian Ministry in the time of War'. It was hugely informative given what is taking place in Israel, Yemen, Syria and Iraq. It was sobering and heart breaking as we thought about how to be church in the context of whom we serve and how we put our faith into action, offer pastoral care and how we stand for peace and justice and represent those who have no voice and those on the margins. I have great admiration for my colleagues, and church members, ministering in such difficult and trying circumstances and for many others across the province where Christianity is a minority faith. Do keep praying for the peace of Jerusalem and for the Middle East. **NB. My induction service with Archdeacon Christopher will take place at Saint Stephen's on Saturday 27 April time TBC. Do continue to keep Paula and I in your prayers as we face the challenges of settling into a new ministry in a new country in a new culture and making new friends. Be sure to keep Ben & Beth and Annabel in your prayers too as they settle into a new way of life without us around.


