### *PRAYERS FOR THE NEXT TWO WEEKS*

This Sunday and the week we pray for all of our brother's and sister's in Christ throughout the world; for Archbishop Justin, shepherd of the Anglican Communion; for Bishop Michael and the diocese of Cyprus and the Gulf, and for our companion Diocese of Exeter, for Bishop Robert and his people and for Great Britain. We pray for St. Mark's Famagusta, a church in a predominately Muslim city, and the vast amount of Christians that are international students in the local university and therefore the church's membership is mostly students. We pray for the city of Famagusta, as parts of it still demonstrate the pain and suffering from the Cyprus dispute.

For the week beginning Sunday the 18<sup>th</sup> October we continue to pray

for all Christians, regardless of denomination or tradition; for the Jerusalem and Middle East Church Association and its associated Trust; for the protestant church in Oman in an historic partnership between the Anglican Church and the Reformed Church of America. This church serves around 1,000 people in four English language congregations, an Arabic and a Korean congregation and host about 60 other congregations in their two compounds.

In this two week coverage we continue to pray for the Persecuted Church worldwide and the spreading of the Christian message throughout the Province of Jerusalem and the Middle East, and our Diocese. We pray for our own Parish of Paphos; the Locum Parish priest Archdeacon Malcolm, our Associate priest Andrew and the Worship Team; and for all involved in the interviewing, taking place on 21st October, of candidates to fulfil the role of our new Parish Priest.

Please keep Anetta Stylianou, from the Diocesan Office, and Cathy Semple, wife of Rev'd Sean Semple, in your prayers as they recover from treatment for cancer and Penny Calder as she prepares for surgery later this month.
