Gift Aid can boost Church finances: If you pay UK income or capital gains tax please help the Church by using the blue Gift Aid envelopes for your Open Plate donations. This will add approximately 25% to any donations you make, as the Church can reclaim the basic rate of tax from your donations. If you are or intend to donate via the Pledge Giving Scheme, you can complete a one-off Gift Aid declaration. **Please ask for a pen if you need one.**

To make a Gift Aid declaration, you will need to pay UK Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax in any tax year greater than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all your Gift Aid donations in that year, or you will be responsible for any difference. Income tax includes tax credits on UK

dividend income. Boosting the Church income in this way will be a very welcome additional contribution to finances.

For our visitors and any residents eligible to Gift Aid:

PLEASE, if you are putting your donation in a Gift Aid envelope, would you make sure that the details on the front of the envelope are completed; if this is not done we are unable to claim the tax refund.

**Robing for Clergy and Readers at Services:** With temperatures rising noticeably, the Worship Team, at their May meeting, renewed their advice to our parish priests to allow them to use their discretion about wearing robes over the hot summer months. When not robing, Clergy will wear their normal clerical attire plus an appropriate stole.

**Canon Anthony:** It is with great sadness that Council received the news from Canon Anthony, at their July meeting, that he feels that due to health issues, he is not able to seek an extension to his contract which ends in early March 2019. Clearly, this will have serious repercussions for the parish but Canon Anthony's health must be our prime concern. Bishop Michael has been notified and we will keep you up to date with information. We wish Canon Anthony well as he plans his future and continues his ministry, with us, until March. We are immensely grateful for all that he has done and for his on-going work, particularly with the wedding ministry. Please keep Canon Anthony in your prayers as he continues with us over the next five and half months and makes his plans for 2019 and beyond. Please also pray for the members of Council

as they start the process of finding a new Associate Priest. Reverend Andrew.

**Swallows and visitors:** with the holiday season gathering pace, it is lovely to be able to welcome an increasing number of visitors. Please take our sunny/warm Paphos greetings back to your own parishes. If you are a 'swallow' please would you fill out a card giving your details so that we can be in contact with you. **Vocations to Ministry:** the church has always sought to provide its Readers, Deacons and Priests from committed Christians who have felt God calling them to serve the Church, in this way. The pattern remains, to this day, and I write to encourage anyone who feels that they would like to explore a possible calling to ministry to speak to either Canon Anthony or myself or to one of our three Readers, in the first instance. What has changed is that the Diocese now has a very clear 'pathway' to ministerial training, be it for either Readership or ordination to the Priesthood, which is proving popular, demanding and very worthwhile.
