### *COLLECT & PRAYERS FOR THIS WEEK*

**Collect for 8<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Trinity:** Lord God, your Son left the riches of heaven and became poor for our sake: when we prosper save us from pride, when we are needy save us from despair, that we may trust in you alone; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

**Alternative Collect for Mary Magdalene:** Almighty God, whose Son restored Mary Magdalene to health of mind and body and called her to

be a witness to his resurrection: forgive our sins and heal us by your grace, that we may serve you in the power of his risen life; who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Amen.

**Anglican Communion:** We pray for all Christians worldwide, the Persecuted Church, and especially at this time, with a Prayer from Bible Lands for The Diaspora of the Iranian Christians scattered in many nations: *Guide with thy pure and peaceable wisdom those who take counsel for the nations of the earth, that in tranquillity thy kingdom may go forward, till the earth is filled with the knowledge of thy love. Amen.*

**Our Province of Jerusalem and the Middle East:** We pray for the Revd Dr Albert Sundararaj Walters, Vicar General and the Diocese of Iran; for the clergy, Revd Christopher Edgar and others who take leadership roles, and wisdom for those who seek the new bishop, and for the congregations of the Episcopal Church in Isfahan, Tehran, Shiraz and Julfa.

**Our Diocese:** We pray for Ministry; that the Church may raise up and support faithful men and women to minister Word and Sacraments. This week we pray for the congregation of Christ Church Aden and the fact that they are still unable to meet due to the security situation there. We continue to pray for the people of the Yemen, and for the dedication of the Muslim staff of the Ras Morbat Eye Clinic.

**In our own Parish of Paphos:** We give thanks for the safe return of our Parish Priest Andrew, hopefully refreshed by his holiday break, for our Associate Priest Canon Anthony and for all members of our worship team; we pray for our Pastoral Care teams, Clinic and Hospital visitors, funeral and bereavement, prayer support group.

Gift Aid can boost Church finances: If you pay UK income or capital gains tax please help the Church by using the blue Gift Aid envelopes for your Open Plate donations. This will add approximately 25% to any donations you make, as the Church can reclaim the basic rate of tax from your

donations. If you are or intend to donate via the Pledge Giving Scheme, you can complete a one-off Gift Aid declaration. **Please ask for a pen if you need one.**

To make a Gift Aid declaration, you will need to pay UK Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax in any tax year greater than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all your Gift Aid donations in that year, or you will be responsible for any difference. Income tax includes tax credits on UK dividend income. Boosting the Church income in this way will be a very welcome additional contribution to finances.

For our visitors and any residents eligible to Gift Aid:

PLEASE, if you are putting your donation in a Gift Aid envelope, would you make sure that the details on the front of the envelope are completed; if this is not done we are unable to claim the tax refund.
