**Collect:** Lord of creation, whose glory is around and within us: open our eyes to your wonders, that we may serve you with reverence and know your peace at our lives' end, through Jesus Christ our Lord.

**The World Council of Churches' Cycle of Prayer:** We pray for Costa Rica; El Salvador; Nicaragua, and Panama. We pray for children and youth who are traumatised by violence and flee to other lands and an end to gang violence and drug trafficking. We also pray for Christians to have the courage to live out the liberating Gospel.

**Our Province of Jerusalem and the Middle East:** We pray for the primate, The Most Reverend Suheil Dawani and his provincial officers. We pray this week for the UNHCR and their work in leading the response for Syrian refugees across the region, and we pray for the WHO who source life-changing medical supplies.

In particular we ask all to hold in your prayers those who are suffering in mind, body or spirit, and for the work of both the Friends Hospice and St. Michael's Hospice and their patients.

Gift Aid can boost Church finances: If you pay UK income or capital gains tax please help the Church by using the blue Gift Aid envelopes for your Open Plate donations. This will add approximately 25% to any donations you make, as the Church can reclaim the basic rate of tax from your donations. If you are or intend to donate via the Pledge Giving Scheme, you can complete a one-off Gift Aid declaration. **Please ask for a pen if you need one.**

To make a Gift Aid declaration, you will need to pay UK Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax in any tax year greater than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all your Gift Aid donations in that year, or you will be responsible for any difference. Income tax includes tax credits on UK dividend income. Boosting the Church income in this way will be a very welcome additional contribution to finances.

For our visitors and any residents eligible to Gift Aid:

PLEASE, if you are putting your donation in a Gift Aid envelope, would you make sure that the details on the front of the envelope are completed; if this is not done, we are unable to claim the tax refund.

Canon Anthony – Retirement: Canon Anthony has notified the Council that he wishes to step down from his Interim Associate Priest's position at

the beginning of February 2020 and to finally retire. His last Sunday as Associate Priest will be Sunday 9th February 2020. At its September meeting, Council asked that the Diocese place an advertisement for a new House for Duty Priest, as soon as possible. Please pray for Canon Anthony as he prepares for his retirement and for the successful recruitment of a new House for Duty Priest. Reverend Andrew.

House for Duty Post – Advertisement: Council took the decision to re-advertise this post and the advertisement will appear in the Church Times on Friday 4th and 11th October. Please pray that, this time, we will be successful in attracting applicants for Canon Anthony's post and that the recruitment process will be straightforward. Reverend Andrew.

Half-Day Parish Review: Some months ago, the Council took the decision to hold a special half-day meeting to review where we are as a parish, to explore how we can respond to changes that are happening, both, in the parish and to external changes, and to investigate how we can make our presence better known in Paphos and Polis and so attract more people to our churches. This meeting will take place during the morning of Thursday 17th October at the Latin Parish hall and will be led by an outside facilitator – Tricia Evans. Archdeacon Christopher will be in attendance. Please pray for this meeting and for all those involved in it. Reverend Andrew.

Diocesan Synod 2020: next year's Synod will be held in Abu Dhabi from Monday 3rd February to Thursday 6th February. Reverend Andrew will be attending along with two representatives from Council. Up to six observers from each parish are welcome to attend, at their own expense. If anyone wishes to take up this opportunity, please let Reverend Andrew know as soon as possible. Reverend Andrew.

Volunteers: volunteers are the backbone of our parish but do you know who the volunteers are who clean St Luke's church, each week or who compile the rosters of readers and intercessors or who work as wedding vergers? Thank you to all who volunteer their services to the parish. We are always in need of your help but we especially need to find two new wedding vergers (speak to Di Sylvester, Linda Turner or Carolyn Hart if you

are interested) and new volunteers to assist the Pastoral Care Team (see Judith Perrett or the Directory in the WNS) and most particularly to lead intercessions in each of our churches. Anyone can volunteer to assist with the above be they permanent resident or swallow. Assistance will be given to help you 'find your feet' with each position. Please prayerfully consider how you might be able to help us to further the work of the parish. Reverend Andrew.

Parish Christmas Cards 2019: Update 3: Thank you to all who have already placed your order and to those of you who are still thinking about it. Our cards are now on sale. Buy your cards, now! Remember, proceeds go towards our church funds and your support is vital. The British High Commission continues to alert us to actions that should be taken as Brexit deadlines loom. In a recent email they asked that we draw particular attention to the following:

1. Ensure that British Ex-pats in Cyprus are correctly registered with the immigration authorities with either MEU1 or MEU3. *Brown ARC books, stamps in passports & old Immigration Permits issued pre Cyprus joining the EU are **obsolete**.*
2. Register for healthcare where applicable.
3. Ensure that their passport is valid for any future travel.
4. Exchange their UK driving license for a Cypriot one.

Sponsored Swim: you will be aware that a small group of dedicated swimmers have been swimming to raise funds for the parish on behalf of the Major Fund Raising Team. Their swimming ended last Saturday when their wonderful efforts were celebrated at a Garden Party at the Latham's villa in Polis. A first estimate of the money raised through the swimming and the Gala Party is €2,800.00. This is a great achievement! Well done and thank you to all who took part and to all who supported the

swimmers and the Gala Party. Thank you, as well, to Peter and Vivienne Latham for hosting this occasion. Reverend Andrew.

Harvest Festival: thank you to all who brought produce along to one of the three harvest collections that were held as part of our celebration of Harvest. It was really encouraging to see our churches full of regular members of the congregation, newly returned swallows and visitors. 
