Anglican Communion: Pray for Rev'd Jennifer Baskerville-Burrows, recently ordained and consecrated as the eleventh bishop of Indianapolis, making her the first black woman to lead a diocese in the history of the US-based Episcopal Church.

The Province of Jerusalem and the Middle East: We pray for the Most Rev'd Suheil Dawani and the Diocese of Jerusalem; for peace and reconciliation between Palestine and Israel; and between Jews, Christians and Muslims.

Gift Aid can boost Church finances: If you pay UK income or capital gains tax please help the Church by using the blue Gift Aid envelopes for your Open Plate donations. This will add approximately 25% to any donations you make, as the Church can reclaim the basic rate of tax

from your donations.

If you are or intend to donate via the Pledge Giving Scheme, you can complete a one-off Gift Aid declaration.

To make a Gift Aid declaration you will need to pay UK Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax in any tax year greater than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all your Gift Aid donations in that year, or you will be responsible for any difference. Income tax includes tax credits on UK dividend income. Boosting the Church income in this way will be a very welcome additional contribution to finances.

For our visitors and any residents eligible to Gift Aid:

PLEASE, if you are putting your donation in a Gift Aid envelope, would you make sure that the details on the front of the envelope are completed; if this is not done we are unable to claim the tax refund.
